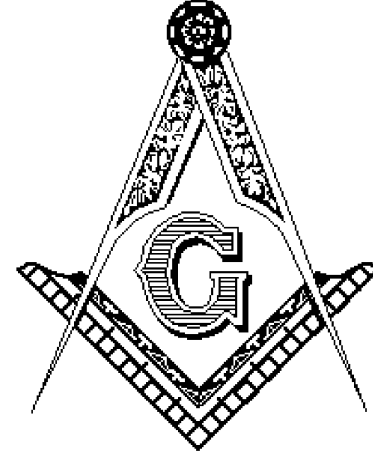

Brethren:

As we move into August I would ask that all members please make an effort to attend the called communications for degree work.
