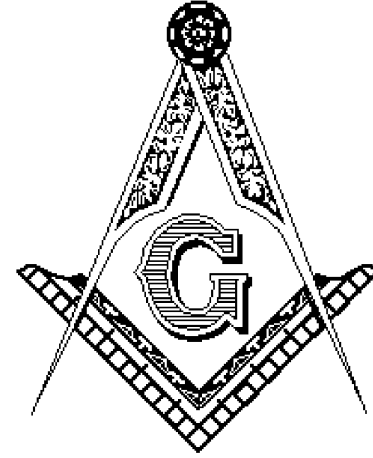

## From the East

Brethren,

First, Masonic Family Day at the Masonic Home of Virginia is this Saturday the 10<sup>th</sup> of October. We will be carpooling from the lodge at 0700 on Saturday morning. The Grand Lodge of Virginia will be dedicating a memorial to the Masonic Veterans who served during D-Day. There will be a parade in full Masonic regalia. Officers will wear jewels and members will wear aprons. This is a rare opportunity to participate in an outdoor, public, Masonic ceremony. This one will be talked about for years to come. For those who don't want to carpool there is also a bus leaving from Kena Temple at 0730. Please contact our Lodge Secretary if you are interested in catching a ride on the bus.

Second, for our lodge activity this month we will be having a picnic at the lodge on the 17<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 2pm. The lodge will provide hotdogs and drinks. There will be a Moon bounce for the kids. The Grand Master of Masons in Virginia has declared that each lodge is to have an open house and open our doors to the community. So we will be conducting an open house in conjunction with this event. This may be a good chance to get some new candidates into the lodge, or it may just be a chance for the lodge to get together and have a good time socializing. Bring the family, bring the kids, a good time will be had by all.

Now, on to the upcoming 2010 Masonic Year; there is an opening at Sr. Warden next year. I regret to inform you that our Senior Warden Gary Akin is not able to continue on to the east next year as he will be pursuing a Masters Degree program. He will not have the time to dedicate to preparing for 2010 and serving the lodge as Master. If the lodge votes it so I will be continuing as Master and Gary will step back to Junior Warden. This will give him two years to complete his degree program and finish his preparations for 2012. Due to these circumstances, there is an opening at Sr. Warden next year. I have already spoken to several people whom I consider likely candidates for my nomination, but have not found someone who is willing to commit to what is required to sit in the east in 2011. Brothers, if you are interested in the nomination for Sr. Warden next year (and master in 2011) please contact me as soon as possible before or at our next stated meeting. To be the Sr. Warden you will need to learn the Sr. Wardens part in the ritual and get your past masters degree. There are plenty of resources in our lodge to help in mastering the ritual so this should not be a problem. The time crunch on this is that the candidate for SR Warden will have to get his Past Masters Degree before he is nominated and elected and it will probably only be offered once more this year. This may be a great opportunity for one of our military brothers who will not be stationed in the area long enough to get all the way through the line but would welcome a chance to be Master. Please give this consideration and get back to me.

Special thanks go to Brother Gary Akin who donated and hooked up a new sound mixer/amplifier to the lodge. All the microphones should be working again at our next meeting.

Grand Lodge is coming up next month. There are rooms available in our reserved block if anyone wants to attend please contact the Secretary or myself.
